The Lancashire Cricket Foundation along with Chance to Shine wish to appoint two Women and Girls Cricket Development Coaches (CDC) that will work on an exciting programme delivery in secondary schools linked to the Club development programme. They will also deliver taster sessions to community groups to support the growth of the number of girls at All Stars Centres.

These exciting roles are a great opportunity to influence girls to try cricket for the first time, develop leaders for the future and support teachers to gain confidence to deliver cricket sessions. The role will be predominantly a coaching role and will work closely with the Women and Girls Cricket Development Officer and the All Stars Activators to support their work programmes along with the Women and Girls Development Manager.

### **Key Responsibilities**

Supervision and Work Planning

The Women and Girls CDC's will be employed by Lancashire Cricket Foundation and line managed by the Women and Girls Development Manager. One role will focus mainly on Greater Manchester with some work outside this area and one role will focus mainly on the East of the County with some work outside this area.

The coaches will be expected to work 37.5 hours per week, which will include evening and some weekend work. The candidate will be required to carry out their duties at such times and on such days that are most effective to perform the responsibilities of the position.

### **General**

The job description outlines the principle accountabilities/main duties relating to this post and does not describe in detail all of the duties required. Other duties may be required to be undertaken from time to time as directed by the Lancashire Cricket Foundation.
