The months from March to September are the busiest time for us here at Lancashire Cricket / Emirates Old Trafford and it is essential that the venue (including its buildings, facilities and equipment) is maintained, prepared and working to the highest standards of operation expected on a world-class stage.

We are therefore looking to recruit Casual Venue Maintenance Assistants to join our extremely busy facilities team to help us to meet the demands of ensuring that the venue and all associated sites are able to stay operational for a huge variety of events 7 days a week.

Ideally, we're looking for people who hold a recognized qualification in a trade such as electrical, plumbing, carpentry or joinery, however we will also consider people who have a good foundation in general maintenance and/or labouring and can demonstrate strong ability in the use of power tools.

Your place of work:

You will be working at Emirates Old Trafford (the home of Lancashire Cricket) which has played host to some of cricket's most iconic moments since 1864 and is now an award-winning world-class venue that has undergone a transformational redevelopment over the last decade.

It is recognised as one of the UK's most prestigious venues for sport, business, leisure and entertainment with a capacity of up to 50,000 people for concerts; 26,000 for international cricket matches; meetings and events spaces for up to 2,000 delegates; a four-star hotel with 150 rooms; and an on-site Caffè Nero.

The venue has played host to some of the world's biggest sporting events, including six ICC Cricket World Cup fixtures in 2019, Ashes Test Matches and world class concerts including Ariana Grande's 'One Love Manchester' concert as well as others by Beyoncé, Rihanna, Foo Fighters and more.

The Role and Responsibilities

As a Casual Venue Maintenance Assistant your role will be extremely varied and include:

- Supporting the maintenance team in reactive and planned maintenance, refurbishment tasks and repairs
- Assisting in preparing the Stadium to the highest standard in order to host large sporting events
- Operating a planned system of general maintenance and repairs
- Travelling to each site or to suppliers as required to carry out any tasks required to full the requirements of the role
- Responding in a timely and flexible manner to urgent or last-minute staff/service requirements
- Having flexibility on availability to be able to provide cover for matchdays and significant events which may fall on weekends, evenings and bank holidays

Requirements

It is essential you can demonstrate that you have:

- Experience of general maintenance or labouring and the ability to use basic hand tools.
- Knowledge of working to strict health and safety guidelines
- An ability to work independently and as part of a team

- Commitment to completing day to day tasks in an effective and timely manner

It would be ideal, but is not essential, if you have:

- A recognised qualification in a trade such as electrical, plumbing, carpentry or joinery
