Stands Open

A, A1, B, C, D, E & Pavilion Terrace

Entry Gates

1 (Talbot Road), 3 & 5 (Brian Statham Way) 10A (Great Stone Road) - All ticket holders. Gate 15 (Talbot Road)- VIP, hospitality and Accessible entrance.

Ticket scanning points

Ticket points at entry gates 1 (Talbot Road), 3 & 5 (Brian Statham Way) and 15 VIP, hospitality and accessible only (Talbot Road), with additional marquee at gate 13.


Food and Drink

There will be multiple food and drinks units in our fan village around the whole stadium. There will be options for dietary needs such as vegan and gluten free.

Water bottle refill points are situated at the back of each stand (excluding stand D), sealed water bottles upto 500ml are permitted.

Bars will be open and serving drinks behind each stand and in the fan village.





Members information

Lancashire Cricket Members can access the Members Pavilion on production of their 2025 Membership card (subject to capacity). Member Guests with valid match day ticket for the Pavilion Terrace can access the Members Pavilion, any guests seated in other areas of the ground will not be permitted into the Pavilion. During play window seating in the Members suite are reserved for accessible seating only.

Members Pavilion dress code - Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is neat, casual dress. Specifically, **non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible** and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire, England and India replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.



This is an all ticket game and Members are required to purchase a ticket to attend this fixture. Members can receive their discount on food and drinks on production of their membership card in the Members Lounge and permanent Lancashire bars around the ground (Stand A,B,C and E)

Restricted and permitted items

No animals allowed onsite except service dogs.

Small umbrellas are allowed in stadium, please be mindful not to obstruct the view of the cricket for other attendees.

Members and ticket holders are reminded of the updated bag policy below

Bags are restricted to ONE PER PERSON and should be no bigger than a standard rucksack (for guidance 45x30x30cm or 18x12x12 inch) so it can fit comfortably under your seat. All bags brought into the ground will be checked and tagged.

Food and drink can be brought into the ground; however, all bags and picnic hampers will be subject to being searched, any items on the prohibited list will not be permitted to enter the ground.

No alcohol, cans or glass containers will be allowed into the ground and drinks will be limited to 500ml sized plastic bottles. Open water bottles containing water/liquid will not be permitted, so please bring empty or unopened water bottles. Please note all bags will be searched on entry to ensure the safety of players, spectators and staff.

Refund Policy

Rain affected days - If, for the day for which the ticket is valid play does not take place OR play is restricted, you will be entitled to a refund of only the match ticket value subject to there being: (a) zero to 10 overs are played of the only or last match of the day and no result is obtained - a full refund; (b) 10.1 overs to 20 overs are played of the only or last match of the day and no result is obtained - a 50% refund. In no other circumstances can money be refunded.
