Parking will be available on car park 3, please enter via gate 11 (Great Stone Road), parking is charged at £6 for Lancashire Members and £12 for non Members

Accessible Parking

Blue badge spaces in car park 3 will be available on a first come first served basis, please enter via Gate 11 (Great Stone Road).

Site Information

Stands Open

Pavilion Terrace is open and Stand A1.

Entry Gates

Pedestrian entrances - Gate 1 (Talbot Road), and the new pedestrian entry gate in between Gate 10A (Great Stone Road).

Ticket Points

Ticket and Membership scanning points at Gate 1 (Talbot Road) and Gate 13 marquee (Wedge car park opposite nets).

Toilets

Toilets available in the Pavilion and Stand A.

Accessibility

Accessible seating available at the back of stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace.
Accessible toilets available in Stand A, and the Pavilion Terrace by use of a radar key.

Food and Drink

There will be snacks and hot drinks available from gates open. Pies, chips and gravy will be available for lunch with a vegan option. Food available in the Members lounge.

The bar will be open in the Members Suite.

Caffe Nero will be open (access via Brian Statham Way).

1864, Life and Prime Members (no need to book) will be able to scan their cards at the entry gates from 10:00.

Flexi and Standard Members will need a ticket to enter the ground, once booked this will be loaded onto your Membership card. If you haven't pre-booked your card will not scan in. This will be part of your ticket allowance.

Lite Members will need to book a ticket to attend and this can be added to the Lancashire Cricket app or Print at Home. Members are encouraged to claim tickets before the matchday.
