The Blackpool Transport bus services running close to the Blackpool Cricket Club are:-

Service 5C - This leaves near Blackpool North Railway Station on Talbot Road and stops on Collingwood Avenue which is a short walk to Blackpool Cricker Club.

Service 18 - This leaves near Blackpool North Railway Station on Buchanan Street. The service stops outside the Main Entrance Gates to Stanley Park adjacent to the Blackpool Cricket Club.

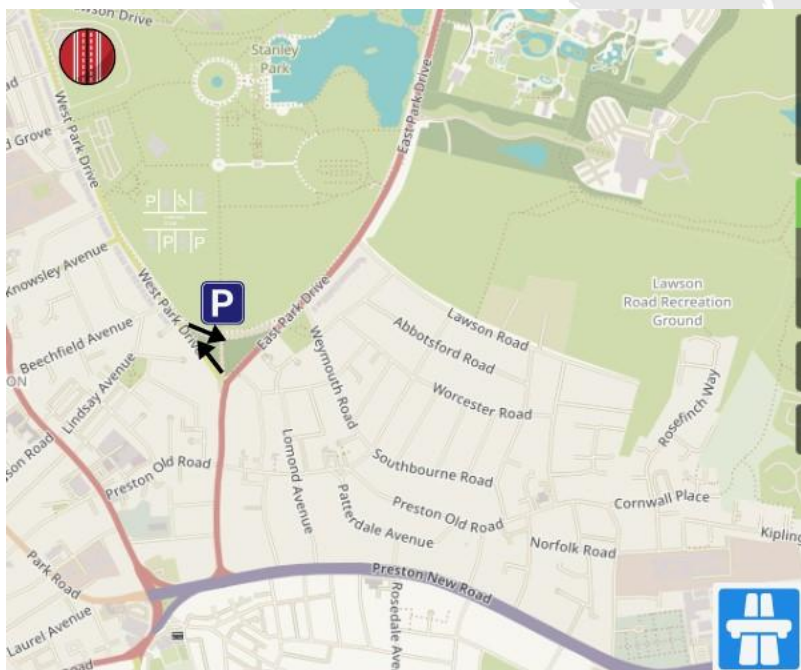

Pavilion Stand (Members only), Grand Stand (between nets and nursery) and loose seating around the ground.

West Park Drive.

Ticket and Members card scanning point

Accessibility

Accessoloo accessible toilet onsite next to the nursery.

Any Flexi or Standard Members who have pre booked a ticket and do not attend will not be able to cancel their ticket after the fixture; the ticket will be deducted from their allocation.

Lancashire Cricket Members can access Members Pavilion and bar on production of 2025 Membership card (subject to capacity).

Any other information

Tickets will be available in the Lancashire Cricket ticket app and the barcode will be activated on the day of the game.

No animals allowed onsite except service dogs.
