Stands Open

Stand A blocks A2-4, B lower, B upper (block BU12), C lower, E & Pavilion Terrace

Entry Gates

Gates 10 and 11 (Great Stone Road) entry for car park

Ticket Points

Ticket and Membership scanning points at Gate 1 and Gate 15 (Talbot Road), Gate 5 (Brian Statham Way) and Gate 7 (Great Stone Road) and the Wedge

Toilets

Toilets will be open in all stands.

Accessibility

Accessible seating available at the front of stands B and C, the back of stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace (Members only)

Accessible toilets available in Stand B, C, E and the Pavilion Terrace by use of a radar key.

Please note this is an all ticket game and Members need to book a ticket to attend.

1864, Prime, Flexi and Standard Members will need a ticket to enter the ground, once booked this will be loaded onto your Membership card. If you haven't pre booked your card will not scan in.

Taster Members will need to book a ticket to attend and this can be added to the Lancashire Cricket app or Print at Home.

Members are encouraged to claim tickets before the matchday to ensure they have a ticket before travelling and to avoid potential queues at our Ticket Office.

The Members' Lounge is available to 2024 Members' on production of Membership card & Members guest with tickets in the Pavilion Terrace.

The Hodgkiss bar will be open from 5pm until close of play. The seating in front of the Edge will be available exclusive to Members and guests all day.

Members Lounge dress code

Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is neat, casual dress. Specifically, non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.
