## **Parking**

General Public on the Wedge Car Park (between the Point and car park 3), enter via Gates 10 and 11

## **By Train**

Greater Manchester's rail connections mean it's easy to get here.

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

## **By Bus**

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport.

## **Metrolink**

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two-minute walk away from the front gates.

### **Stands Open**

Stand A (blocks A2 to A4), Stand B (upper only), Stand E (block E6 only) and Pavilion Terrace

### **Entry Gates**

1 (Talbot Road), 3 (Brian Statham Way) pedestrian

10 and 11 (Great Stone Road) - vehicle only

### **Ticket Points**

Ticket and membership card scanning points at entry gate between Hotel and Pavilion

### **Toilets**

Toilets will be open in Stand A, Stand B and the Members Suite (Members only)

### **Accessibility**

Accessible seating available between Stand A and Pavilion, and on the Pavilion Terrace (Members only)

### **Food and Drink**

A pop up food outlet, serving hot food will be available on all days, located in between the Hotel and Pavilion

Stand A bar open (located between the Pavilion and Hilton Garden Inn)

Hilton Garden Inn Grille and the Edge will be open for lunch, access via Hotel entrance

Caffe Nero will be open - access via Stand A tunnel

Members' long room will be serving hot food and drink (Members only)

### **Members**

#### **Parking**

Parking is available on the Wedge Car Park (between the Point and car park 3),

Parking is offered on a first come first served basis, Blue Badge holders, Car Park pass holders and 1864 Members will have access from 1 hour and 30 minutes before start of play, Members without a parking pass will have access from 1 hour before start of play. Please don't arrive earlier than this as access to the car parks won't be possible.

Parking is charged at £6 for Lancashire Members and payable at the Members bar.

#### **Other useful information**

Vice Presidents and 1864 Members can scan in at Pavilion Reception from 09:30

Prime and Life Members will be able to scan their cards at the entry gates from 10:00

Flexi and Standard Members will need a ticket to enter the ground, once booked this will be loaded onto your membership card. If you haven't pre booked your card will not scan in.

Taster Members will need to book a ticket to attend and this can be added to the Lancashire Cricket Ticket app or Print at Home.

Members can access the Members' Lounge on production of their 2024 membership card or Members ticket

Members can receive their discount on food and drinks on production of their membership card or Members ticket

Members who have pre-booked a Member ticket on the Middle Balcony for a County Championship or Metro Bank One Day Cup match can also use their membership card to access this area and will not need to download a digital ticket. Any Member Guests on the Middle Balcony will still require a digital ticket to enter this area. Tickets on the Middle Balcony are sold on a reserved seat basis, so please ensure that you make a note of your full seat details by clicking [HERE](#) to log into the Member Portal and select 'Memberships & Tickets' from the 'MY BOOKINGS' menu.

Members and guests can access The Edge from 11am to 4pm Friday and Monday and 12 to 4pm Saturday and Sunday (only food purchased in The Edge can be consumed in suite), the Hodgkiss bar will be open until close of play. The seating in front of the Edge will be available exclusive to Members and guests all day.

Jimmy's bar (hotel terrace) will be open from 10am until the Edge opens and 4pm until close of play. Tea and coffee will be available to purchase.
