Parking

There will be limited parking on car park 3 for this fixture on a first-come first-served basis, enter via gate 1 (Talbot Road) gate 11 on (Great Stone Road). Parking charged at £6 for Members and £12 for non Members.

Accessible Parking

Blue badge spaces in car park 2 will be available on a first-come first-served basis, please enter via Gate 1 (Talbot Road) or 11 (Great Stone Road).

By Train

Greater Manchester's rail connections mean it's easy to get here.

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

By Bus

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport, Greater Manchester has an extensive bus network operated by the Bee Network.

By Metrolink

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

By Bike

If you are cycling to the ground, you will be able to lock up your bike at the racks located underneath The Point. The easiest entry point to access this area is via Gate 1 on Talbot Road.

Site Information

Stands Open

Stand A ,B,C, E and Pavilion Terrace (Members only)

Entry Gates

1 (Talbot Road), 3 and 5 (Brian Statham Way).

Gate 6 (Brian Statham Way) will be open for exit at close of play for accessible guests

Please note there will be no pedestrian entry or exit from Great Stone Road

Membership card and ticket scanning points

Between hotel & Pavilion, Gate 5 (Brian Statham Way) and Gate 7 (next to Indoor Cricket Centre) for those parking on car park 3.

Toilets

Toilets will be open in Stand A B,C,E and Pavilion Terrace (Members only).

Accessibility

Accessible seating available in Stand B,C,E (access via the Point) and the Pavilion Terrace (Members only).

Accessible toilets available in Stand A, Stand B and Stand E by use of radar key and Pavilion Terrace (Members only).

Changing places facility in Stand A tunnel and on the wedge car park (at the back of Stand E).

Food and Drink

There will be hot food at Stand A bar under the hotel.

Caffe Nero is open all day and access via Stand A tunnel.

Members information

Vice Presidents and 1864 Members can scan in at Pavilion Reception from 09:30

Life and Prime Members (no need to book) will be able to scan their cards at the entry gates from 10:00.

Flexi and Standard Members will need a ticket to enter the ground, once booked this will be loaded onto your membership card. If you havent pre-booked your card will not scan in.

Lite Members will need to book a ticket to attend and this can be added to the Lancashire Cricket app or Print at Home.

Members who have already booked a ticket but are no longer able to attend, please contact the Ticket Office by emailing membership@lancashirecricket.co.uk to allow another Member the opportunity to use the seat. As far as possible, we request any Flexi or Standard Members who have pre-booked a ticket and cannot attend to notify the Ticket Office by emailing membership@lancashirecricket.co.uk. Otherwise, the ticket will be deducted from their allocation.

The middle balcony will be open for Members who have paid for an upgrade ticket. Upgrade tickets are available for £5. Members who have pre-booked a Member ticket on the Middle Balcony for this fixture can use their membership card to access this area. Any Member guests on the Middle Balcony will still require a digital ticket to enter this area. Tickets on the Middle Balcony are sold on a reserved seat basis, so please ensure that you make a note of your full seat details by clicking <https://memberportal.lancashirecricket.co.uk/> to log into the Member Portal and select 'Memberships & Tickets' from the 'MY BOOKINGS' menu.

Members can access the Members Lounge on production of their 2025 membership card.

Members and guests can access The Edge from 12 noon till 4pm Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday (opening hours slightly different to usual due to the Bank Holiday days), the Hodgkiss bar will be open until close of play. The seating in front of the Edge will be available exclusive to Members and guests all day.

Members can receive their discount on food and drinks on production of their membership card or Members' ticket

Any Members who would like a printed copy of the Members' booklet, please present your membership card at Pavilion Reception or the Ticket Office to pick up your copy. The booklet contains information which will help you during the season.

Pitch access

Spectators will be able to access the outfield at the tea break during Rothesay County Championship fixtures taking place at Emirates Old Trafford. Please note that no food or drink may be brought onto the pitch. Every effort will be made to allow access on each fixture, please be aware that there may be occasions when access won't be possible.

This may include weather affected days. We will keep spectators informed on the status of pitch access on the day.

The official Lancashire Cricket store will be open from gates open until after close of play, we will be running a clearance sales with many items upto 70% off.

Emirates Old Trafford is committed to being a welcoming venue for all, we ask that our guests are considerate & respectful to each other.

Smoking in stands and covered areas is not permitted (this includes the use of e-cigarettes and vapes).

No animals allowed onsite except service dogs.

Bag searches will be in operation at the entry gate points. All bags being brought into the stadium will be checked and tagged before access to the ground is granted. The number and size of bags that may be brought into the Ground will be restricted to ONE BAG PER PERSON and this bag must be a standard ruck sack size (45x30x30cm), so that it may fit comfortably under your seat.

Bags are restricted to ONE PER PERSON and should be no bigger than a standard rucksack (for guidance 45x35x30cm) so it can fit comfortably under your seat. All bags brought into the ground will be checked and tagged.

The Multi Faith room is available and is situated in the Pavilion Tunnel (at back of Reception)

The first aid room is situated in the Indoor Cricket Centre

Sensory room -.the room is situated in our Player and Media Centre of Emirates Old Trafford where users, both young and old, can get away from any overwhelming outside distractions. Our sensory room is a dedicated space that allows those with sensory processing issues the opportunity to watch a game in a safe and secure environment.
