By Train

Rail links to AO Farington Cricket Ground are good and the nearest train stations are: Lostock Hall which is a 11 - 15 minute walk away, and Leyland which is a 35 minute walk away or a short bus journey.

Walking route from Lostock Hall train station to AO Farington Cricket Ground is shown on map below.

The 111 service runs from Leyland stops on the doorstep of AO Farington Cricket Ground.

Bike Racks

There are several racks available for bicycle parking, located between the two ovals, on the approach to the Pavilion.

By foot

There are two pedestrian gates on Stanifield Lane, no access via vehicle gate (see map below).



Parking

There is a limited amount of parking available on-site, we encourage attendees to car share or use public transport.

Parking at AO Farington Cricket Ground will be free of charge.

The Pavilion bar will be open

Only food and drink purchased in the Pavilion can be consumed in the Pavilion.

Pavilion dress code

Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is neat, casual dress. Specifically, non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.



Other useful information

Tickets can be purchased at the entrance gate by card payment only.

No animals are allowed onsite except service dogs.

No alcohol or glass bottles are allowed, for a full list of restricted items please see the link below.

Please note at outgrounds and AO Farington Cricket Ground only, soft drinks in cans are now permitted in addition to plastic bottles upto 500ml.
