By Train

Greater Manchester's rail connections mean it's easy to get here.

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

By Bus

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport.

Greater Manchester has an extensive bus network operated by different commercial bus companies.

Please note: The individual operators will always have the latest information about your service.

By Metrolink

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

By Bike

If you are cycling to the ground, you will be able to lock up your bike at the racks located underneath The Point. The easiest entry point to access this area is via Gate 15 on Talbot Road.

Stands Open

Stand A, B, C, E & Pavilion Terrace

Entry Gates

From 11:00 Gate 1 (Talbot Road) and Gate 14

From 13:00 Gate 5 (Brian Statham Way), Gate 7 (Great Stone Road) and Gate 15 (Talbot Road) - Family and Accessible entrance.

Ticket Points

Ticket and membership points will be open from 13:00: Gate 5 (Brian Statham Way), Gate 7 (car park 3), between the Hilton Garden Inn & Pavilion and between the Pavilion & The Point. And Gate 14 from 14:00.

Toilets

Toilets will be open in all stands and there will be temporary toilets set up around site.

Accessibility

Accessible seating available at the front of Stand B and C, the back of Stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace (Members only).

Accessible toilets available in Stand A,B,C,E, Changing Places on the Wedge (at the back of Stand E) with the use of a radar key and the Pavilion Terrace (Members only).

Food and Drink

There will be multiple food and drinks units in our fan village around the stadium. There will be options for dietary needs such as vegan and gluten free.

Members Lounge dress code:

Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is neat, casual dress. Specifically, non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.

Other useful information

Lancashire Cricket and Trafford Council are set to host the biggest family day out of the summer when the Vitality Blast and Trafford LIVE come together.

The joint-family event will combine both Trafford Council and Emirates Old Trafford fan village areas with fun-filled family activities for everyone. Gates for Trafford Live will open from 11am and gates for cricket from 1pm (match ticket required to access cricket).

Road closures will be in place on Talbot road from Great Stone Road to traffic lights on Brian Statham Way/Warwick Road - from 10:00 to 15:00.

Emirates Old Trafford is committed to being a welcoming venue for all, we ask that our guests are considerate & respectful to each other.

Ticket Office (Brian Statham Way) will be open from 09:00 until innings break.

No animals allowed onsite except service dogs.

Sensory room - We now have a private pitch-facing Sensory Room.
