By Train

Greater Manchester's rail connections mean it's easy to get here.

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

By Bus

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport.

Greater Manchester has an extensive bus network operated by different commercial bus companies.

Please note: The individual operators will always have the latest information about your service.

By Metrolink

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

By Bike

If you are cycling to the ground, you will be able to lock up your bike at the racks located underneath The Point. The easiest entry point to access this area is via Gate 1 on Talbot Road.

Accessibility

Accessible seating available in between Stand A and Pavilion (in between Stand A and Pavilion) the Pavilion Terrace (Members only) and Stand E (days 3-4 only due to an event taking place in the Point on days 1 and 2)

Food and Drink

A pop up food outlet, serving hot food will be available on all days, located in between the Hotel and Pavilion

Stand A bar open (located between the Hotel and Pavilion) for Day 1 and 2

Atrium bar in the Point will be open days 3 and 4 only due to an event taking place in the Point on days 1 and 2

Hilton Garden Inn Grille will be open for lunch

Caffe Nero will be open - access via Stand A tunnel

Parking

Car park 2 (Talbot Road), the wedge (next to stand D gap and nets) & 3 (Great Stone Road)

Parking is offered on a first come first served basis, Blue Badge holder, Car park pass holders and 1864 Members access from 1 hour and 30 minutes before start of play, Members without parking pass access from 1 hour before start of play. Please don't arrive earlier than this as access to the car parks won't be possible.

If any Members are attending the open sessions on days 1 or 2 they will be able to access car park from 1 hour 30 minutes before start of play

Parking is charged at £6 for Lancashire Members and payable at the Members bar.

Other useful information

Vice Presidents and 1864 Members can scan in at Pavilion Reception from 09:30

Prime and Life Members will be able to scan their cards at the entry gates from 10:00, for any Members attending the Open Sessions in the Club Suite they will be able to scan in at Pavilion Reception

Flexi and Standard Members will need a ticket to enter the ground, once booked this will be loaded onto your Membership card. If you haven't pre-booked your card will not scan in.

Taster Members will need to book a ticket to attend and this can be added to the Lancashire Cricket app or Print at Home.

Flexi, Standard and Taster Members will need to pre-book tickets for all matches as per their membership ticket allocation. Any Member Guest tickets or additional tickets purchased by Members will still require a digital ticket to enter the ground. Taster Members will still require a digital ticket to enter the ground.

Prime Members do not need to pre-book tickets and can use their membership card to enter all County Championship and Metro Bank One Day Cup matches at Emirates Old Trafford.

Members who have pre-booked a Member ticket on the Middle Balcony for a County Championship or Metro Bank One Day Cup match can also use their membership card to access this area and will not need to download a digital ticket. Any Member Guests on the Middle Balcony will still require a digital ticket to enter this area. Tickets on the Middle Balcony are sold on a reserved seat basis, so please ensure that you make a note of your full seat details by clicking [HERE](#) to log into the Member Portal and select 'Memberships & Tickets' from the 'MY BOOKINGS' menu.

Members can access the Members Lounge on production of their 2024 membership card or Members ticket

Members and guests can access The Edge from 11am to 4pm (on days 2 and 3 The Edge will be available from 12 to 4pm), the Hodgkiss bar will be open until close of play. The seating in front of the Edge will be available exclusive to Members and guests all day.

Members can receive their discount on food and drinks on production of their membership card or Members ticket

Friday 3 and Saturday 4 May 10-11am - Open house session will take place in the Club Suite, updating Members on The Hundred, for any Members wishing to attend sessions they will have early access to the car park and stadium from 9:30

Friday 3 May - Schools Open Day, attendees will be seated in Stand C.

Sunday 5 May (lunch break) - Former Players Q&A will take place in the Members Suite
