### **By Train**

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

### **By Bus**

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport.

Greater Manchester has an extensive bus network operated by different commercial bus companies.

### **By Metrolink**

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

There will be a 6-minute service on Altrincham line Wednesday to Friday, Saturday and Sunday there will be a 7.5 minute service, further details on link below.

### **By Bike**

If you are cycling to the ground, you will be able to lock up your bike on car park 3, please ask your nearest steward to assist you. The easiest entry point to access this area is via Gate 8 on Great Stone Road.

#### **Stands Open**

A, A1, B, C, D, E & Pavilion Terrace

#### **Entry Gates**

1 (Talbot Road), 3 & 5 (Brian Statham Way) 7 (Great Stone Road) - All ticket holders. Gate 15 (Talbot Road)- VIP and Accessible entrance.

Hospitality entrance at Gate 1 (Talbot Road)

#### **Ticket Points**

Ticket points at entry gates, with additional marquee at gate 7

#### **Toilets**

Toilets will be open in all stands. There will be temporary toilets set up around site

#### **Accessibility**

Accessible toilets are available in Stand A,B,C,E and Pavilion Longroom (Members Only) in addition Changing places facility (accessible toilet facility) will be open in Stand A tunnel and on the wedge car park at back of Stand E.

Accessible seating is available at the front of stands B and C, the back of stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace. 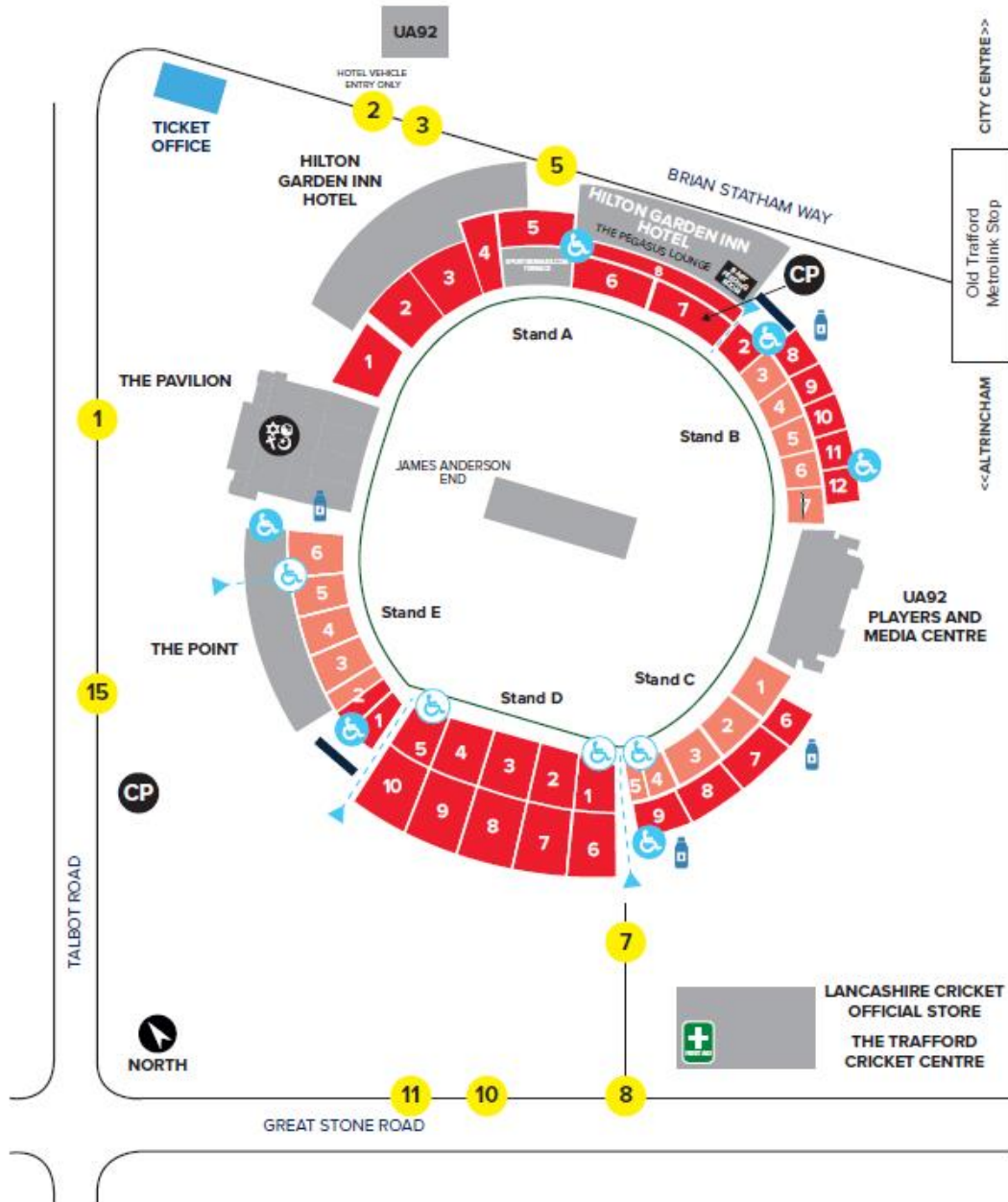
#### **Food and Drink**

### **Useful information**

Lancashire Cricket Members can access Members Pavilion and bar on production of 2024 Membership card (subject to capacity). Member Guests with valid match day ticket for the Pavilion Terrace can access the Members Pavilion, any guests seated in other areas of the ground will not be permitted into the Pavilion. During play window seating in the Members suite are reserved for accessible seating only.

Members Pavilion dress code - Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is neat, casual dress. Specifically, **non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible** and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire, England and Sri Lanka replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.

This is an all ticket game and Members are required to purchase a ticket to attend this fixture.

Members can receive their discount on food and drinks on production of their membership card in the Members Lounge and permanent Lancashire bars around the ground (Stand A,B,C and E)

### **Restricted and permitted items**

No animals allowed onsite except service dogs.

Small umbrellas are allowed in stadium, please be mindful not to obstruct the view of the cricket for other attendees.

Food and drink can be brought into the ground; however, all bags and picnic hampers will be subject to being searched, any items on the prohibited list will not be permitted to enter the ground.

No alcohol, cans or glass containers will be allowed into the ground and drinks will be limited to 75cl sized bottles. Open water bottles containing water/liquid will not be permitted, so please bring empty or unopened water bottles. Please note all bags will be searched on entry to ensure the safety of players, spectators and staff.

#### Refund Policy

Rain affected days - For days 1 to 4 of the Test Match: If, for the day for which the ticket is valid, play does not take place OR play is restricted, you will be entitled to a refund of only the match ticket value subject to there

being: (a) zero to 15 overs played - a full refund; (b) 15.1 overs to 30 overs played - a 50% refund. In no other circumstances can money be refunded.
