The Blackpool Transport bus services running close to the Blackpool Cricket Club are:-

Service 5C - This leaves near Blackpool North Railway Station on Talbot Road and stops on Collingwood Avenue which is a short walk to Blackpool Cricker Club.

Service 18 - This leaves near Blackpool North Railway Station on Buchanan Street. The service stops outside the Main Entrance Gates to Stanley Park adjacent to the Blackpool Cricket Club.

Please note at outgrounds only, soft drinks in cans are now permitted along with plastic bottles upto 500ml.
