Members and ticket holders are reminded of the updated bag policy below

Bags are restricted to ONE PER PERSON and should be no bigger than a standard rucksack (for guidance 45x30x30cm or 18x12x12 inch) so it can fit comfortably under your seat. All bags brought into the ground will be checked and tagged.

Parking

There will be a limited number of spaces on Bruntwood office car park (Great Stone Road) from 13:00 on a first come first serve basis charged at £6 for Lancashire Members and £12 for non-Members.

Pre booked blue badge parking is located on Bruntwood car park (postcode for Sat Nav is M32 0SF), please confirm your name on arrival.

Stands Open

Stand A – A1 A2, A3, A5, A6 and A7.
B Lower – BL2, BL3, BL4, BL5, BL6 and BL7, B Upper – BU10, BU11 and BU12.
C Lower - CL1, CL2 and CL3, C Upper blocks CU6 and CU7.
Stand D – D1, D2, D3, D4 and D5
Stand E – E1, E2, E3, E4, E5, and E6.
Pavilion Terrace (Members only).

Entry Gates

Pedestrian entrances - Gate 1 (Talbot Road), Gate 3 (Brian Statham Way), Gate 5 (Brian Statham Way) and the new pedestrian entry gate in between Gate 10 & 11 (Great Stone Road).

Ticket and membership card scanning points

Ticket and membership scanning points at Gate 1 and Gate 15 (Talbot Road), Gate 3 and Gate 5 (Brian Statham Way) and Gate 13 marquee (Wedge car park opposite nets).

Accessibility

Accessible seating available at the front of stands B,C, the back of stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace (Members only)

Accessible toilets available in Stand A, B, C, E and the Pavilion Terrace by use of a radar key.

Food and Drink

There will be multiple food and drinks units in our fan village around the whole stadium. There will be options for dietary needs such as vegan and gluten free.

Bars will be open under Stands A, B, C, E, Members Suite and Cask Ale in between the Pavilion and the Point.

Toilets

Toilets will be open in Stand A, B, C, E and Pavilion (Members only).

Members

Please note this is an all ticket game and Members need to purchase a ticket to attend.

1864, Prime, Flexi and Standard Members will need to book a ticket to enter the ground, that will be loaded onto their membership card. If no ticket has been booked the membership card will NOT scan.

Lite Members will need to purchase a ticket to enter the ground, that will be available in the Lancashire Cricket Ticket app or as Print @ Home

Members are encouraged to purchase tickets before the matchday to ensure they have a ticket before travelling and to avoid potential queues at our Ticket Office.

The Members Lounge is available to all 2025 Members on production of their membership card. It is also available to Members Guests who hold a ticket for the Pavilion Terrace.

MEMBERS' DRESS CODE

Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major cricket club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is smart, casual dress. Specifically, non-cricket replica shirts and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts (including polo shirts) are acceptable, as are Lancashire replica shirts. Sandals worn with socks will be accepted.

Ticket Plus

You are able enter via any gate but gate 15 is available and located near the point. On entry please report to the Point reception desk where our event staff will show you to the suite area.

Tickets will be available in the Lancashire Cricket ticket app before the game and the barcode will be activated on the day of the game.

Ticket office will be open from 09:00 until close of innings break.

No animals allowed onsite except service dogs.

Bag searches will be operation at the entry gate.

No alcohol or cans or glass bottles allowed, for full list of restricted items please see link below.
