### MEMBERS' DRESS CODE

Consistent with the **prestige of being a Member of a major cricket club**, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is smart, casual dress.

Specifically, **non-cricket replica shirts and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed**. Tailored shorts and collared shirts (including polo shirts) are acceptable, as are Lancashire replica shirts. Sandals worn with socks will be accepted.

#### 1864 Members Dress Code

The 1864 Suite dress code is **smart casual**. 1864 Members and their guests are requested **not to wear replica kits, t-shirts, blue denim, or shorts**.

We encourage 1864 Members and their guests to wear smart clothing that positively elevates the 1864 Suite match day experience. Please note that we reserve the right to refuse admittance to the 1864 Suite if a Member or their guest is not dressed appropriately.

### PITCH ACCESS

Spectators will be able to access the outfield at the tea break during Rothesay County Championship fixtures taking place at Emirates Old Trafford. Every effort will be made to allow access on each fixture but please be aware that there may be occasions when access won't be possible. This may include weather affected days. We will keep spectators informed on the status of pitch access on the day.

We kindly request that spectators don't take any food or drink onto the pitch and keep a distance from the square and any players training. Any breaches may result in pitch access being reviewed.

A GUIDE...

## DO I NEED TO BOOK A TICKET?

The Club are happy to inform Members that **all Member match tickets will be loaded onto membership cards for the 2026 season**. This means that if you have claimed a Member ticket for a Men's Rothesay County Championship, Metro Bank One Day Cup or Vitality Blast match, you won't need to download a digital ticket and can simply present your membership card to enter the ground.

**Flexi, Standard and Lite Members will still need to pre-book tickets** for all matches as per their membership ticket allocation. Any Member Guest tickets or additional tickets purchased by Members will still require a digital ticket to enter the ground. Lite Members will still require a digital ticket to enter the ground as they are not issued with a membership card. If a match day is rained off, the ticket allocation will be reloaded onto the account and available to use against another fixture.

**Roses T20 Vitality Blast fixture is reserved seats**, all remaining Vitality Blast fixtures are general admission unreserved seating in all open stands, please book a ticket and select a seat in any open stand on arrival to the stadium. **Please note the Metro Bank One Day Cup & Vitality Blast knockout stages are not included** in the membership; ticket details will be communicated should we qualify for a home fixture.

## GUIDE TO BOOKING TICKETS

Visit [cricket.lancashirecricket.co.uk/memberportal](https://cricket.lancashirecricket.co.uk/memberportal)

- Log in to your existing ticketing account (please use the **'FORGOTTEN YOUR PASSWORD?'** option if you are unsure of your log in details).
- Scroll down the front page to find your **desired format of cricket** (Vitality Blast, Rothesay County Championship and Metro Bank One Day Cup).
- The next five days of play in each competition are listed on the home screen beneath the relevant headers as above. You can **view matches at later dates** by using the arrow on the right hand side of the screen.
- Once you have found your desired day of play, **click on the date to open the ticket screen** for that particular day of play.
- Scroll down the screen to find your **preferred stand** to view from for that day.
- Find the **'Member Ticket'** tariff within that area, and select your desired number of Member tickets (one ticket per Member, per day) then scroll down and select **'Add to Basket'**.
- The next screen will confirm the tickets that you have added to your basket. If you intend to book any further tickets, select **'Continue Shopping'** to return to the ticketing home screen or alternatively click **'BUY NOW'**.
- On the **'Delivery method'** screen, select **'Member Card'**. Select **'Continue'**.
- On the **'Order Summary'** screen, you will need to select the relevant Members as applicable for each ticket within your basket (this can be yourself on each ticket if this is across multiple days).
- Scroll down and tick the **'I have read and accepted the Club's terms and conditions and the Code of Conduct'** and then select **'COMPLETE YOUR ORDER'**.
- You will receive a **confirmation e-mail** with details of your booking and your membership card will be valid for use at the gate on matchday.
- Member guest tickets can be claimed in the same manner as above; select **'Member Guest'** tariff instead of **'Member Ticket'** and the delivery methods will be available as the Lancashire Cricket tickets app or as print at home.
- Tickets for The Hundred are processed via the ECB ticketing channels. Members will receive an e-mail with instructions on how to claim any relevant Member tickets for these matches.

## UPGRADING TO THE MIDDLE BALCONY (on level 2 of Pavilion)

- To book an upgrade to the Middle Balcony please **follow steps 1-4** on the guide to booking tickets.
- Scroll down to **'Middle Balcony'** seat category and add **'Member Ticket'** for a Member or **'Member guest'** if using one of your guest allowance. These is also an option to pay £20, including admission and Middle Balcony upgrade, for a Member's paying guest.
- It will cost £5 to upgrade per Member, per day. \*Junior Members have access to purchase upgrade, anyone under 14 should be accompanied by an adult.
- Guest tickets will be permitted access upon paying the £5 upgrade.
- We advise Members to book in advance as capacity will be limited for certain days
- Access will be added to Member's card. Please ensure that you retain your booking confirmation, detailing your seat information, for use on the day. Guest tickets and paying guest tickets will be distributed via Print at Home or Lancashire Cricket Tickets app as relevant to the option selected at checkout.
- Please note seating on the Middle Balcony is unreserved.

### ACCESSIBLE SEATING AREA\*

#### The Edge

Six wheelchair spaces and six carer seats.

#### Stand B

Eight wheelchair spaces, eight carer seats and accessible seating at the front of the stand.

#### Stand C

Nine wheelchair spaces, nine carer seats and accessible seating at the front of the stand.

#### Stand E

Nine wheelchair spaces, nine carer seats and accessible seating at the back of the stand, accessible via the lift in The Point.

#### Pavilion Terrace

We have space for up to five wheelchairs and five carer seats. (County Championship and One-Day Cup games only)

### CHANGING PLACES

Our changing places facility will be available at the back of Stand A and E. Access is via radar key, our stewards have access to a radar key if you need help with access.

### NURSING ROOM

Our nursing and baby feeding room is available at the back of Stand A.

### ASSISTANCE DOGS

Assistance dogs are permitted into Emirates Old Trafford and Lancashire outground venues.

The initiative includes lanyards and pins branded with the distinctive Sunflower symbol, which discreetly indicates that the wearer may require additional support, help or a little more time.

The displaying of the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower will help the Club to offer better support to its staff, Members, supporters, and all those visiting Emirates Old Trafford throughout the year.

## SENSORY ROOM

**We have a private pitch facing Sensory Room, located in the Hilton Garden Inn, where users, both young and old, can get away from any overwhelming outside distractions.**

Our sensory room is a dedicated space that allows those with sensory processing issues the opportunity to watch a game in a safe and secure environment. The room is complete with soft comfortable seating, bubble columns and a fibreoptic tail to create calming visual distractions. The room is restricted to one family for a maximum of 2 hours. The room is available to any match ticket holder free of charge.



## METROLINK

The nearest stop is **Old Trafford**, this is at the back of **stand B** and at end of **Brian Statham Way**, the tram is serviced on the Altrincham line. You can access Old Trafford from other lines by changing at Trafford Bar and Cornbrook. There are local park and ride stations which include **Brooklands**, **Sale Waterpark** and **Stretford**.

## CYCLING

Emirates Old Trafford is easy to get to by bike with **cycle paths leading up to the ground on Talbot Road** from either end of the city. Bike racks are located around the stadium perimeter, specifically the Ticket Office, Gate 3 and Gates 10/11. Manchester cycle routes and parking, as well as Starling Bike docks can be found in the travel assistant.

## CAR PARKING

**Rothsay County Championship** and **Metro Bank Cup Seasonal passes** are available to purchase which covers access to the Vitality County Championship and Metro Bank One Day Cup fixtures at Emirates Old Trafford.

Subject to availability - Daily parking (including blue badge) will be available on a first come first serve basis at Members rate of £6 per day. Parking payment can be made at the Members bar or Pavilion reception.


