Parking

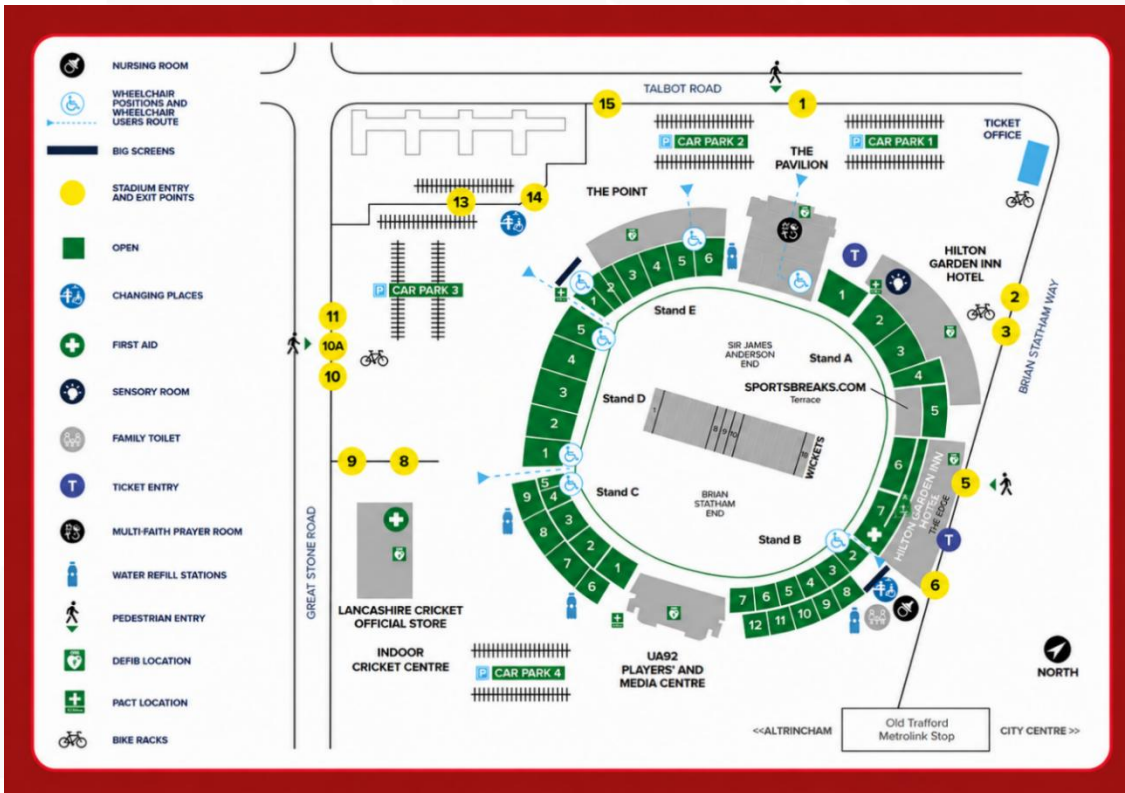

Stands Open

Stand A, B, C, D, E and Pavilion Terrace (Members only)

Entry Gates

1 (Talbot Road), 3, 5 (Brian Statham Way) and 10A (Great Stone Road)

Ticket and membership card scanning points

1 (Talbot Road), 3 & 5 (Brian Statham Way), 10A (Great Stone Road) - All ticket holders.
Gate 1 (Talbot Road) - VIP, Hospitality and Accessible entrance.

Toilets

Toilets will be open in Stand A tunnel, B, C, E, Pavilion Terrace (Members only) and temporary toilets around the site.

Accessibility

Accessible seating available in stand B, C, E (access via the Point) the Pavilion Terrace (Members only)
Accessible toilets available in Stand A, Stand B, Stand E by use of radar key and Pavilion Terrace (Members only)
Changing place facility in Stand A tunnel and on the wedge car park (at the back of Stand E)

Food and Drink

There will be multiple food and drinks units in our fan village around the whole stadium. There will be options for dietary needs such as vegan and gluten free.

Bars will be open under Stands A, B, C, E, in the Members Suite and Cask Ale in between the Pavilion and the Point.

Ticket+

Please enter the ground via any gate. Once inside the stadium, please head to The Point reception where our event staff will scan your tickets and issue a wristband. Ticket+ guests have access to a pay bar. The Point has a standing viewing balcony or there will be unreserved seating is available in Stand E.

Members

Please note this is an all ticket game and Members need to book a ticket to attend. Seating is reserved seats and Members will receive email with confirmation of booked seat.

1864 and Vice Presidents will have access with Membership card.

Prime, Flexi and Standard Members will need a ticket to enter the ground, once booked this will be loaded onto your Membership card. If you haven't pre-booked your card will not scan in.

Lite Members will need to book a ticket to attend and this can be added to the Lancashire Cricket app or Print at Home.

Members are encouraged to claim tickets before the matchday to ensure they have a ticket before travelling and to avoid potential queues at our Ticket Office.

The Members' Lounge is available to 2026 Members' on production of Membership card & Members guest with tickets in the Pavilion Terrace.
