By Train

Greater Manchester's rail connections mean it's easy to get here.

By Bus

By Metrolink

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

By Bike

If you are cycling to the ground, you will be able to lock up your bike at the racks located underneath The Point. The easiest entry point to access this area is via Gate 15 on Talbot Road.

A, B, C, E & Pavilion Terrace

Entry Gates

Gate 1 (Talbot Road) 2&3 (Brian Statham Way), 7 (Great Stone Road) - All ticket holders. Gate 15 (Talbot Road) - Family & Accessible entrance.

Gates for Trafford Live will open from 11am and gates for cricket from 1pm.

Toilets

Toilets will be open in all stands and there will be temporary toilets set up around site

Accessibility

Changing places facility (accessible toilet facility) will be open next to the Indoor Cricket Centre.

Seating available at the front of stand C, the back of stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace, these are all available to pre book

Members Lounge dress code

Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is neat, casual dress. Specifically, non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.

Lancashire Cricket Club and Trafford Council are set to host the biggest family day out of the summer when the Vitality Blast and Trafford LIVE come together on Father's Day.

The joint-family event will combine both Trafford Council and Emirates Old Trafford Fan Village areas with fun-filled family activities for everyone. Gates for Trafford Live will open from 11am and gates for cricket from 1pm.

Road closure will be in place on Talbot road from Great Stone Road to traffic lights on Brian Statham Way/Warwick Road - from 10am-5pm.

Due to the construction site for our new development, there is no through access between stand A and stand B.

The official Lancashire Cricket store will be open from gates open until after close of play.
