---

### About LancsTV+

---

#### What is LancsTV+?

LancsTV+ is a new premium tier of LancsTV – Lancashire Cricket's dedicated digital platform. It is the exclusive home of all Lancashire Men's matches streamed live online, plus a range of exclusive content including documentaries, behind-the-scenes footage, and in-depth player interviews.

#### What content is included with LancsTV+?

LancsTV+ includes all Lancashire Men's live match streams, exclusive documentaries including part Two of the Lancashire Women's documentary 'Building Champions', charting the team's historic double in 2025, alongside a dedicated feature celebrating the career of Men's Head Coach Steven Croft 'The Man Behind The Rose', as well as in-depth player interviews, behind-the-scenes footage and features.

#### When does LancsTV+ launch?

The first exclusive LancsTV+ fixture is Lancashire Men vs Middlesex in the Rothesay County Championship at Emirates Old Trafford on Friday 8 May.

### Membership

---

#### I'm already a Lancashire Member – do I need to pay extra?

No. Existing Lancashire Members receive automatic access to LancsTV+ at no additional cost as part of their membership package.

When LancsTV+ is launched, you will just need to login to the platform using your existing membership credentials.

#### Will LancsTV+ be available to all categories of membership?

Yes – all Lancashire Cricket Members will have access to LancsTV+ content, regardless of membership category.

#### How do I become a Member of Lancashire Cricket?

Becoming a Member is quick and easy – and it's the best way to get the full Red Rose experience, including access to LancsTV+.

Once you're a Member, your LancsTV+ access will unlock automatically when the service goes live – just use the same login as your Members' Portal.

## **If I cancel my Lancashire Cricket membership, will I still have access to LancsTV+?**

If you cancel your Lancashire Cricket membership, you will lose access to LancsTV+, however you will still have access to the free to view LancsTV content.

## **How do Members login to LancsTV+?**

Once LancsTV+ is launched, Members will be able to login using their existing membership credentials – no new account or additional setup is required.

## **Pricing**

---

### **How much does LancsTV+ cost?**

For non-members, LancsTV+ is available for just £20 per year – giving you access to all Men's live streams and exclusive content for the full year.

### **How do I sign up for LancsTV+?**

Non-members can gain access to LancsTV+ for £20 per year. LancsTV+ will be available to purchase in due course.

### **Can I buy a day pass or single match access to LancsTV+?**

We understand that some supporters may prefer more flexible viewing options, such as day or match passes. We will be considering this and will communicate any updates in due course.

## **Live Matches**

---

### **What matches will be streamed on LancsTV+?**

All live streams in the following competitions will be streamed exclusively on LancsTV+:

- Rothesay County Championship matches
- Men's Metro Bank One-Day Cup matches
- Men's Vitality Blast T20 matches

### **Will there be a stream on YouTube at all?**

For the above matches, a YouTube stream will be available which will have commentary, a scorecard and replays.

The first ten minutes for all Men's matches will have full production on YouTube before switching to the above feed.

### **What about the Men's Roses T20 fixture?**

We are excited to announce that this fixture will be streamed on LancsTV+.

This fixture will also be broadcast live on Sky Sports, as usual. This will be the first time the 'War of the Roses' fixture in the Vitality Blast will be streamed.

### **Will women's matches still be free to watch on YouTube?**

Yes. As part of Lancashire Cricket's ongoing commitment to growing the women's game, all women's domestic fixtures will continue to be broadcast free on YouTube as well as LancsTV.

## Devices and Compatibility

---

### What devices are supported?

LancsTV can be accessed via any device with a web browser and internet connection.

### Can I install LancsTV on my device?

LancsTV isn't available as a standalone app just yet – but you can still add it to your home screen for quick access. Here's how, depending on your device:

#### iPhone or iPad (Safari):

1. Open LancsTV in Safari.
2. Tap the Share icon (the square with an arrow).
3. Scroll down and tap **Add to Home Screen**.
4. Tap **Add** in the top-right corner.

LancsTV will now appear on your home screen – ready to launch in a single tap.

#### Android (Chrome):

1. Open LancsTV in Chrome.
2. Tap the three-dot menu in the top-right corner.
3. Tap **Add to Home screen** or **Install app**.
4. Confirm by tapping **Add**.

You'll now have LancsTV on your home screen – just like an app.

### Can I watch on my Smart TV?

The Club is investing in a number of connected TV apps and more information on this will follow in due course.

---

#### *Option 1: Use your Smart TV's built-in browser*

If your Smart TV has a web browser (an app you can use to go online), you can watch directly on your TV:

#### Steps:

1. On your TV remote, open the web browser app.
2. In the address bar, type: [www.lancstv.co.uk](http://www.lancstv.co.uk)
3. Login with your LancsTV account details.
4. Choose the video you want to watch – it will play just like it does on your phone, tablet or laptop.

#### Tips:

- This works best on newer Smart TVs (2018 onwards).
- Some older TV browsers may not play videos smoothly – if that happens, try Option 2 below.

#### **Option 2: Cast from your phone or tablet to your TV**

This is where you play the video on your phone or tablet and send it to your TV screen wirelessly. This works if your phone and TV are connected to the same Wi-Fi.

#### **If you're using an iPhone or iPad:**

1. Make sure your iPhone/iPad and TV (or Apple TV) are on the same Wi-Fi network.
2. Open Safari (or your usual internet app) and go to [www.lancstv.co.uk](http://www.lancstv.co.uk).
3. Login and start playing the video.
4. Swipe down from the top-right of your screen to open Control Centre.
5. Tap Screen Mirroring, then choose your TV or Apple TV from the list.

**If you're using an Android phone or tablet:**

1. Make sure your phone and TV (or Chromecast) are on the same Wi-Fi network.
2. Open Chrome (or the internet app you normally use) and go to [www.lancstv.co.uk](http://www.lancstv.co.uk).
3. Login and start playing the video.
4. Swipe down from the top of your screen to open the quick settings menu.
5. Tap Cast, Smart View, or Screen Mirroring – the wording might be slightly different depending on your device.
6. Choose your TV from the list to start casting.
