Parking

There will NOT be any general parking on site for this fixture.

Blue badge spaces in car park 3 (Great Stone Road) on first come, first serve basis.

By Train

Greater Manchester's rail connections mean it's easy to get here.

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

By Bus

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport.

Greater Manchester has an extensive bus network operated by different commercial bus companies.

Please note: The individual operators will always have the latest information about your service.

By Metrolink

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

By Bike

If you are cycling to the ground, you will be able to lock up your bike at the racks located underneath The Point. The easiest entry point to access this area is via Gate 15 on Talbot Road.

Members Cricket Forum will now take place in the Edge (New Hotel building) at close of play Thursday 26 July (Day 2). Weather interruptions may influence an earlier start time should play be called off before the scheduled close of play.

Director of Cricket Performance Mark Chilton, Club Secretary Lee Morgan and Members' Representative Group (MRG) Vice Chair Chris Bent will all be happy to answer questions, whilst CEO Daniel Gidney and Chris Peacock (Board Member responsible for Member Communication and Services) will also be available on the evening.

We are looking forward to engaging with Members on how to shape Forums in the future, while we will also provide a cricket update and an update from the MRG.

The Edge will be open exclusively for Members, Members will have access to the outdoor padded seats - with raised viewing - and the outside bar adjacent to the seats from when gates open. Members will also have access to The Edge (restaurant) from 11am when play starts until 4pm, following which the outside bar will be available until close of play.

Although we will do our very best to break down the Ashes set up in a short time frame – which is scheduled to finish on Sunday evening - there may be some slight disruption caused by the de-rig on Tuesday 25 July.

Members will be able to enter via the Sportsbreaks.com Terrace (Stand A, Block 5), whilst food and drink will be available to purchase with a Member discount of 10% on items purchased. Only food and beverages purchased from The Edge can be consumed within restuarant.

All seating in the New Development is unreserved and available on a first-come-first serve basis. An elevator is available in the New Development (for any accessible needs) – which opened for the first time this week for the Men's Ashes Test at Emirates Old Trafford.

Other useful information

Tickets will be available in the Lancashire Cricket ticket app and the barcode will be activated on the day of the game.

Smoking in covered areas and stands is not permitted (including e cigarettes and vapes).

The official Lancashire Cricket store will be open from gates open until after close of play each day.

Library in the Cricket Centre open before play each day from 10am and during lunch/tea. There's also a large amount of 2nd hand cricket books / Wisdens for sale.
