By Train

Please note rail strikes are in place on Thursday 20th and Saturday 22nd, please check the national rail website for further details.

Manchester Piccadilly, Deansgate Castlefield and Victoria all have access to tram stops, which will take you directly to the ground.

By Bus

Emirates Old Trafford is easily accessible via public transport.

By Metrolink

If you are travelling via the Metrolink, the Old Trafford stop is located directly behind Emirates Old Trafford and is just a two minute walk away from the front gates.

There will be a 6 minute service on Altrincham line Monday to Friday 7am-8pm and Saturday 9am-6pm, outside of these times there will be a 12 minute service

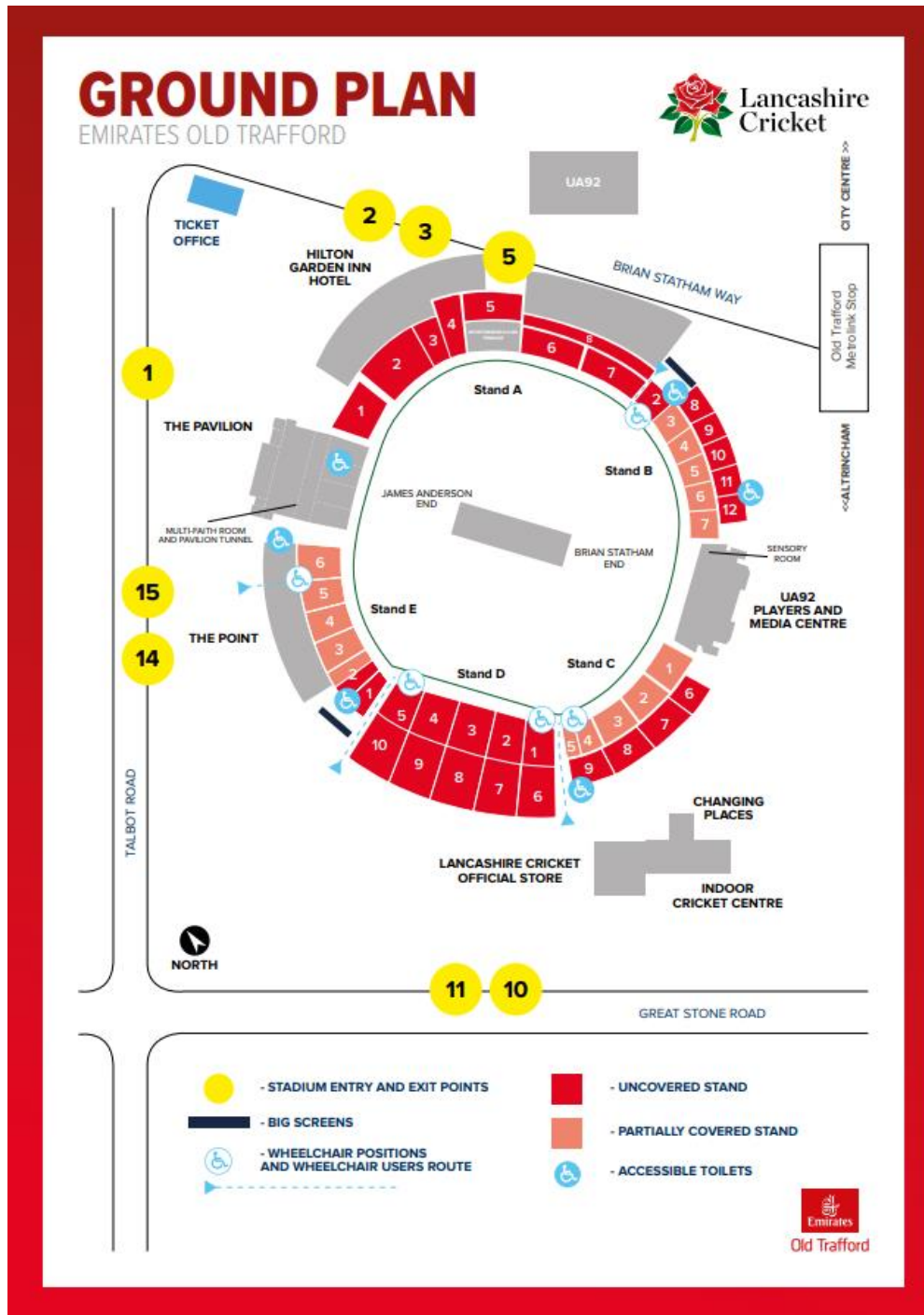
By Bike

1 (Talbot Road), 2,3 & 5 (Brian Statham Way), 7 (Great Stone Road) - All ticket holders. Gate 15 (Talbot Road)-VIP and Accessible entrance.

Ticket points at entry gates.

Toilets

Toilets will be open in all stands. There will also be temporary toilets set up around site.

Accessibility

Changing places facility (accessible toilet facility) will be open next to the ICC, for the convenience of our guests with access needs, this facility is accessible with the use of a Radar key. If you do not possess a radar key please speak with the nearest steward for assistance. We recommend that user of this facility are assisted by a helper. Please note – user of the hoist are required to supply their own harness.

Accessible seating is available at the front of stands B and C, the back of stand E and on the Pavilion Terrace. All ticket enquiries should be directed to the ticket office in advance of the match day.

Food and Drink

There will be multiple food and drinks units in our fan village around the whole stadium. There will be options for dietary needs such as vegan and gluten free.

Water bottle refill points are situated at the back of each stand (excluding D stand), sealed water bottles upto 500ml will be permitted.

Other useful information

Lancashire Cricket Members can access the Members Longroom on production of a valid 2023 membership card (subject to capacity) to purchase food and drinks. Viewing the match from within Longroom and seating on Pavilion Terrace is reserved **only** for those who have purchased a Pavilion Terrace ticket.

Members in the Longroom who hold a ticket for any other areas of the ground will need to utilise their booked seat to watch the match. This will enable as many Members as possible access the Longroom facilities throughout day.

Member Guests with valid match ticket for the Pavilion Terrace can access the Members Longroom.

Members Pavilion dress code - Consistent with the prestige of being a Member of a major Cricket Club, the minimum requirement for adult entry to the Members' areas for both Members and guests is smart casual dress. Specifically, non-cricket replica shirts are not permissible and torn jeans or trousers are not allowed. Tailored shorts and collared shirts including polo shirts are acceptable, as are Lancashire & England replica shirts. Sandals with socks will be accepted.

This is an all ticket game and Members are required to purchase a ticket to attend this fixture. Membership cards will not be valid for access.

The dress code for our hospitality suites is smart casual. Please dress appropriately for the event, smart jeans, trousers, tailored shorts, smart trainers and collared shirts are all acceptable. We request that football shirts are not worn within the hospitality suites.

Tickets will be available in the Lancashire Cricket ticket app and the barcode will be activated on the day of the game.

Ticket Office is open from 8am to close of tea interval on each match days, the Ticket Office is situated on Brian Statham Way. The ticket office can assist with all ticket enquiries including if you have misplaced your ticket (please note the lead booker is required to be able to make amends/request a reprint of tickets).

The main reception is situated at the Pavilion reception for any lost property and general enquiries.

Smoking in covered areas and stands is not permitted (including e cigarettes and vapes).

Please note Brian Statham will be closed for vehicle access from 06:00 to 23:59 each match day.

The official Lancashire Cricket store will be open from gates open until after close of play. 3 pop up shops are situated around the ground.

Programmes can be bought from various outlets around the grounds.

Match day entertainment - Roaming entertainers Stilt Cricketers, Stilt Batteristas, Living Statue DJ (fan zone at back of Pavilion), Live singers (Located behind stand C and on the Wedge next to the nets). face painter, garden games including crazy golf will be situated in family zone (adjacent to the Ticket Office).

Refund Policy

Rain affected days - For days 1 to 4 of the Test Match: If, for the day for which the ticket is valid, play does not take place OR play is restricted, you will be entitled to a refund of only the match ticket value subject to there being: (a) zero to 15 overs played - a full refund; (b) 15.1 overs to 30 overs played - a 50% refund. In no other circumstances can money be refunded.
